Cirencester Town is a community club and is keen to develop it's association with local people, commercial operations and provide for the public a focal point for football excellence and social activity in the area.

The Cirencester Arena has been built as part of Cirencester Town Football Club's ongoing development programme, The Arena is the first indoor facility of its kind outside of the professional game.

The Arena's third generation surface known as Astroplay, is the same surface currently being used by top teams such as Manchester United, Celtic and FC Porto at their indoor training facilities, so were in good company providing an excellent surface and brilliant playing experience for everyone.

The Cirencester Arena was erected in August 2004, and is host to a number of activities which include, five and six-a-side football leagues, corporate events, children's birthday parties, children's coaching courses, local professional and amateur football clubs training, friendly and private hire bookings.
